County Council

The election is over now, and things are slowly returning to normal. A meeting to welcome all the new members has been held. A number of training sessions have been organised. A meeting of the Full Council will be held on Thursday. The Leader will be selected at this meeting. Cabinet members will then be selected next week. Everyone will also be informed of which Committees they will members.

Locally

A meeting has now been held with residents who are concerned about the changes that have taken place at Bryn Teg, including lighting near the Lake, the draining of land means that formerly wild places are now lawns, as well as diverting the course of rivers and streams on the site. I think planning permission is required in order to do these three things, and have written to the Head of Planning asking for an update on the situation.

Still in discussions with officials, to try to solve the problem of the 4 cars parked at the bottom of Allt Goch.

Enquiries have been made about mending the approach road to the cemetery road, received an acknowledgment, and awaiting a more comprehensive reply.
