- Cynnal a chadw dau faes chwarae yn Llanrug (Nant y Glyn a Pwll Moelyn)
- Cyflwyno sylwadau ar geisiodau cynllunio
- Gofalu am gysgodfannau bysiau
- Gyfrifoldeb am pedwar
- Diffibriliwr sydd wedi lleoli tu allan i'r Sefydliad Coffa, Spar Llanrug, Y Glyntwrog a London Garage Cwm y Glo. Mae'r Cyngor yn ystyried ychwanegu at y pedwar yma a byddai yn croesawu awgrymiadau am leoliadau addas.

What has Llanrug Community Council achieved?

2020 – 2022 has been a challenging period for everyone, the council succeeded to

- Set up an outdoor gym in Cwm-y-Glo to meet local needs.
- Maintain two playing fields in Cwm-y-Glo (Dolafon and Allt Goch)
- Maintain the skating park in Cwm-y-Glo
- Maintain two playing fields in Llanrug (Nant y Glyn and Pwll Moelyn)
- Present comments on planning applications
- Maintain bus shelters
- Responsible for four defibrillators which are located outside the Memorial Institute, Llanrug Spar, Glyntwrog London Garage, Cwm y Glo - the council is considering adding to these and would welcome any suggestions on future locations.
- Between 2020 and 2022, £11,300 has been distributed to local organisations
- Provide Christmas decorations and organise a Christmas decorations competition for 2022.
- Keep Llanrug's youth club open
- Maintain the car park adjacent to Llanrug Spar
- Provide grit to residents during the Winter



What is a Community Council?

The Community Council is the lowest tier of local government, but also the most important as it is the closest tier to the people it serves.

The Council

The Community Council comprises fourteen members (councillors) who represent three wards, Llanrug, Ceunant and Cwm-y-Glo. The current members of the Council are listed over the page with their contact details. Meetings of the council are held on the 3rd Tuesday of every month via Zoom, and the Council welcomes members of the public to attend. The council is supported by four Committees, Leisure and Amenities, the Cemetery Committee, Food and Wellbeing and Finance and Resources. - Maintain public footpaths
- Grass cutting the front of the estates at Llanrug and Dolafon, Cwm-y-Glo
- Established and administrated food and welfare schemes during the pandemic and the Council has succeeded in obtaining a grant to ensure that its food scheme continues until December 2023
- Management of Llanrug Cemetery (which has won a National prize throughout the United Kingdom in 2021 2022
- Establish and administer a digital system for inspecting, managing, and administration of the Cemetery and a search facility which can be found <https://cemeterysearcher.co.uk/search/llanrug>
- Undertake, maintain and implement risk assessments for the Cemetery
- Planting of daffodil bulbs and other flowers in the community
- On Remembrance Sunday, the Council Chair will present a wreath on behalf of the Council

From where does the money come from?

The Council receives most of its income via the precept (what is paid via Council Tax). For 2022 / 2023 the council's precept was £77,000 which means that for a property in Band D, the annual sum is £67.68 which is approximately £1.30 per week on average.
