

Grass Cutting and General Maintenance in Llanrug Cemetery.

How often is the grass in Llanrug (Community Council) Cemetery cut and what is the annual timetable for this?

There is no set timetable with specific dates. The Community Council have a frequency- based schedule of cuts appertaining to the growing season, March-October, which is monitored by the Cemetery Sub-Committee and the Clerk to the Council.

How is the grass cutting and the overall maintenance of the Cemetery paid for?

Maintenance of the Cemetery areas is financed by the Cemetery budget, which is part of the overall Community Council budget decided annually by the Councillors.

Who cuts the grass in the Cemetery?

The Community Council contracts suitably persons to do this work. This follows a rigorous tendering process that occurs every three years. The Contractor is answerable to the Council for the standard and execution of their work.

Who sets the rules about grass cutting, memorial maintenance and repair, and general tidiness in the Cemetery?

These rules are set by the Cemetery Sub-Committee and approved annually by the members of the Community Council. The Cemetery rules are to be found on the Community Council web site, as well as on the noticeboard in the Cemetery. Copies can also be provided by contacting the Clerk to the Council.

How can any suggestions, observations, complaints, etc. regarding the Cemetery be made known to the Community Council?

Such communication can be made via the contact details of the Councillors and the Clerk as found on the Community Council web site. Alternatively, members of the public can attend Council meetings to make their views known (more detail via the Council clerk).
