1360. To receive a joint report by Councillors Beca Brown and Berwyn Parry Jones, the members for Llanrug and Cwm y Glo on Gwynedd Council

1361. To receive a report by the Chair of the Cemetery Committee

Reported by Councillor Philip Roberts, Chair of the Committee that the committee had met on 4 September at the cemetery. The following matters were discussed.

- Review the practical work required at the cemetery:
- Resolved that new signs should be placed regarding the use of the parking spaces and to respect the cemetery.
- Resolved to contact the bench owner to inform that maintenance work is required on the property.
- Resolved that work is required on some of the gravestone's stakes before any repair work can be undertaken on the gravestones.
- Resolved to grant permission for work to be undertaken to place 'kerbs' on a memorial as the grave is in the oldest part of the cemetery with similar memorials.

- Noted again that the road to the church is in a poor condition which requires urgent attention.
- A meeting was held at the time with the landowner of the land opposite the cemetery to proceed with the tender for the work to the cemetery wall.

Reported by Councillor Avril Jones, Chair of the committee that the committee had met on 10 September 20203. The following matters were discussed.

- That the maintenance work on the playing fields is ongoing
- That a new bench has arrived at Cwm y Glo playing field. Its waiting to be fitted.
- That a new swing has arrived to replace the broken one as identified in the risk assessment
- Work in hand to repair the fence at Pwll Moelyn
- Work will commence in November on the Skating Park
- Work to remove the wood fence at Pwll Moelyn to commence.
- Prepare a questionnaire for Ysgol Gynradd Llanrug on what additional equipment they would like to see at the playing field.
- The rules for the playing fields were approved.
- Prepare 'No Dogs' signs for every entrance to a playing field.
- Check that the wreath for Remembrance Sunday is at the Institute
- Ask about the cost of a defibrillator for Crawia.
- Christmas 2024 arrangements, trees, and lights to be on by 29 November.
- Promote the home decoration competition. The competition will run between 29 November and 15 December
- Judging will take place w/c 16 December between 6 and 7 pm
- As usual a chocolate box for everyone taking part.
- This year's prizes, 1st Prize £75, Second £50, Third £25
- Training arrangements for the defibrillator will be held soon.
- Walk the public footpaths in April.
