Introduction by Councillor Rhys Parry, Council Chair

As your chair for the year 2024/25 I would like to thank Meirion, our clerk for all his work. I would also like to express thanks to my fellow councillors for their continuous work in implementing the precept for the benefit of the community. We are fortunate that we have at present a small but active group of councillors. During the last year we are fortunate that we have been assisted by volunteers from the community which makes Llanrug an excellent place to live. Llanrug Community Council is an active council and has achieved much with the precept. It is also conscientious in responding to concerns and challenges that arise regarding controversial planning applications. It



is a pleasure to report that two new Defib have been sited in the area; we have worked with and responded to a request by a resident who was enthusiastic about having a Defib in Crawia. We have been proactive in responding to the concerns of residents about the land of the former schoolhouse. There will be an opportunity for us as a community council to be the voice of the community in shaping the future regarding housing developments, the future of the former Cwm y Glo school and much more. During the year, it is hoped that there will be much more collaboration and clear communication with the elected members of Gwynedd Council, other organisations and more importantly with the residents and local organisation/businesses. We are looking forward to the Cemetery project which will be realised and will ensure a clear and sustainable future with the extension of the burial spaces available. As the Council Chair I am keen to continue to deliver for the benefit of our community. To operate efficiently we would welcome those with new ideas and those able to challenge to join us. Regarding the specific activities that the council does:

Litter Picking

We have decided not to arrange specific litter picking days but if anyone would like to undertake this service, the council can provide the equipment. Please contact the clerk or other members of the community council, if interested.

Llanrug Cemetery

Again, this year we have invested in the cemetery. The risk assessment will continue to be undertaken on the memorials in accordance with our continuous programme to ensure that the memorials are safe and meet the latest safety criteria of the industry.

There is more to be done, therefore, if you would like to contribute to the maintenance costs of the cemetery, please contact the Clerk.

It was an honour to announce that Llanrug Cemetery had won a silver award for the third consecutive year in the Cemetery of the Year competition throughout Britain.

This is a competition which is held and approved by the following professional bodies:

- Memorial Awareness Board (MAB)
- Institute of Cemetery and Crematorium Management (ICCM)
- The Federation of Burial and Cremation Authorities (FBCA)
- The Society of Local Council Clerks (SLCC)
- British Register of Accredited Memorial Masons (BRAMM)

The council is preparing for the long-term future and expenditure by extending the cemetery. You will see that a wall has been erected around the extended part of the cemetery and more work will continue to be done during 2025 / 2026.



Playing Fields

A significant sum has been allocated towards our playing fields, and it is good to see that the outdoor gym at Cwm y Glo is being used regularly.

The maintenance of our playing fields is a priority which is in accordance with our Health and Safety policy, and I would like to thank everyone who is keeping an eye to ensure that no damage is caused.

Recently, the council has engaged with primary school children to ask what equipment they would like to see at Pwll Moelyn playing field. We had a positive response and picnic tables came to the top of the list. The council has purchased two picnic tables, and they will be sited in the coming weeks.

Climbing equipment was second on the list. The council will look into providing this type of equipment in 2025 / 2026.

The council would like to thank the school children for taking part in the survey.

Mae dydd Iau 8 Mai 2025 yn nodi 80 mlynedd ers Diwrnod VE (Victory in Europe) pan ddaeth yr Ail Ryfel Byd i ben yn Ewrop.

Arweiniodd y newyddion hir ddisgwyliedig at ddatliadau digymell yn torri allan ar draws y wlad. Cyhoeddwyd gwyliau cenedlaethol a daeth pobl o bob cefndir at ei gilydd i nodi'r foment.

Ni ddaeth y rhyfel yn y Dwyrain i ben tan 15 Awst 1945, pan ildiodd Japan. Dathlwyd y diwrnod ar draws y byd fel 'Victory over Japan' (Diwrnod VJ).

Y Cyngor

Caeau Chwarae

Mae swm sylweddol wedi ei neilltuo tuag at ein caeau chwarae ac mae'n braf gweld fod campfa awyr agored Cwm y Glo yn cael defnydd cyson.

Mae cynnal a chadw ein caeau chwarae yn flaenoriaeth sy'n cyd-fynd â'n polisi Iechyd a Diogelwch a dymunaf ddiolch i bawb sydd yn cadw llygaid i sicrhau nad oes difrod yn cael ei achosi.

Yn ddiweddar, fe ymgysylltodd y cyngor gyda plant yr ysgol gynradd i holi pa offer fyddent yn hoffi ei weld yn cae chwarae Pwll Moelyn. Cafwyd ymateb positif iawn a beth ddaeth ar frig y rhestr ond byrddau picnic. Mae'r cyngor wedi pwrcau dau fwrdd picnic a byddent yn cael eu gosod yn yr wythnosau nesaf.

Yn ail o'r offer roedd offer dringo. Bydd y cyngor yn edrych i fewn i ddarparu offer o'r math yma yn ystod 2025 / 2026.

Dymuna'r cyngor ddiolch yn fawr iawn i blant yr ysgol am eu rhan yn yr arolwg.

What has Llanrug Community Council achieved in 2024 / 2025?

The council has succeeded to:

- Maintain the outdoor gym at Cwm y Glo and the provide an appropriate surface to improve the opportunity to use the gym.
- Maintain two playing fields at Cwm y Glo (Dolafon and Allt Goch)
- Maintain the skate park at Cwm y Glo.
- Maintain two playing fields at Llanrug (Nant y Glyn and Pwll Moelyn)
- Submit observations on planning applications.
- Maintain bus shelters.
- Responsible for nine defibrillators which are located outside the Memorial Institute, Premier Llanrug, Glyntwrog, Ysgol Brynrefail, London Garage, Y Frican, Tyn y Coed Caravan Park by Bryn y Maen, Ceunant, and by the houses at Crawia.
- During 2024 / 2025, grants of £6,950 have been distributed to local organisations.
- Provide Christmas decorations and organise a Christmas house decoration competition for 2025.
- Fund and keep Llanrug youth club open; approximately 136 children have registered with the club with up to 60 children attending regularly.
- Maintain the car park by Premier.
- Maintain the public footpaths.
- Grass cutting the front of the estates at Llanrug and Dolafon, Cwm y Glo.
- Set up and administrating the food bank scheme.
- Daffodil bulbs and other flowers have been planted in the area.



Where does the money come from?

The Council receives most of its income from the precept (which is paid from council tax). For 2024/25 the council's precept was £85,000.

VE and VJ Day

Thursday, 8 May 2025 commemorates 80 years since VE Day (Victory in Europe) when the Second World War in Europe came to an end.

The long-awaited news resulted in spontaneous celebrations throughout the country. National holidays were announced and people from all backgrounds came together to commemorate the moment.

The war in the East did not end until 15 August 1945, when Japan surrendered. The day was celebrated all over the world as 'Victory over Japan' (Diwrnod VJ).

The Council

The Community Council comprises fourteen members (councillors) who represent three wards, Llanrug, Ceunant and Cwm y Glo. The current members of the Council are listed over the page with their contact details. Meetings of the council are held on the 3rd Tuesday of every month via Zoom. The Council welcomes members of the public to attend. Five Committees serve the council, Leisure and Amenities, Cemetery, Food and Wellbeing, Finance and Resources, Health and Safety. The agenda and minutes of the Council are on our website www.llanrug.cymru.

We need you. Become a councillor?

Meetings of Llanrug Community Council are held virtually which means that you can join the meeting from anywhere. The council provides a laptop for the work of the council and a specific e-mail address.

An allowance is available to cover broad band costs and other expenses. There is also an allowance available to cover care commitments.

The current Chair is a father of two and as he can attend meetings virtually, this means that childcare responsibilities does not prevent him from undertaking the role of councillor.

There are three empty seats on the council at present. This is an opportunity for you to put your name forward to become a councillor, and the council will be co-opting in the coming months.

- Are you enthusiastic about your local community?
- Is there something you would like to change?
- Are you ready to make challenging decisions?
- Why don't you stand for the issues that are important to you and become a councillor?

The Council can consider any individual who is a British citizen, a citizen of the Commonwealth, the Irish Republic, or the European Union. You must be at least 18 years old to become a Councillor and should meet at least one of the following criteria: -

- registered as a local government elector for the area of the authority named above; or
 - for the whole of the previous 12 months occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the community named above; or
 - the principal or only place of work during the last 12 months was in the community named above; or
 - you have resided in the community, or within 4.8 kilometres during the whole of the last 12 months.
- You cannot become a councillor if you are: -
- subject to a bankruptcy restrictions order or an interim order
 - in the previous 5 years before the election day, have been convicted in the United Kingdom of a crime and have been sentenced to prison (whether suspended or not) for 3 months or more without the option of a fine.
 - you are working for the council that you wish to become a councillor for (but you can work for other local authorities, including the main authorities representing the same area).
 - disqualified under any legislation involving corrupt or illegal practices.
