Councillor Philip Roberts, the council's representative on the governing body reported as follows.

The third meeting of the board of governors of Ysgol Gynradd Llanrug was held on 7.7.25.

A report on the current situation of the school was provided by the Headteacher.

These are the issues to note 267 pupils on the register and a similar figure is projected for 25/6.

attendance is at 93.36% and is continuing to increase annually.

the behaviour of a small number of pupils at the start of the school year has been challenging – by working within the school, with external assistance, and with the involvement of the families the situation has improved.

effective joint working with families in general in several ways e.g. reports, special evenings, Friends of the School

investment in staff e.g. professional training, academic activities, welfare, and social sessions for pupils, e.g. music lessons, sports, School Council, Urdd.

The budget for 25-26 was submitted for 25-26 and the staff implications, classes etc.

Reported that discussions with Gwynedd Council regarding the Business Plan for the School House site is on-going.

It was also pleasing to see that the Headteacher had noted in the report that a good relationship has been established between the School and Community Council and is continuing regarding several issues.

A report was submitted, for information, on the Public Meeting arranged by the Community Council on 1 July regarding the Glanffynnon Housing Scheme.

Noted that the council had asked for more information regarding the incident. No further response received about the incident. Noted that a risk assessment of the equipment had only recently been undertaken by professional assessors and no risk had been identified in the report.
